## ABSTRACTING STANDARDS NOVEMBER 2011

**OBJECTIVE:** The objective is to establish guidelines and standards for the integration of new practices to NorthShore Medical Group. These guidelines will ensure that the practice and physician needs are met by abstracting and/or scanning core medical data and patient information in preparation for the patient's visit with the physician. The following will outline patient information abstracted and/or scanned from a patient's medical chart.

**ABSTRACTING: Standard Abstracting Information**: Standard information will be abstracted from patient's medical chart (paper or electronic) and keyed into EPIC. **Duplicate Patient Information**: Chart information abstracted by the Resource Abstractor will not be scanned into EPIC.

**LOGISTICS:** Upon complete abstraction of the patient's medical chart, the abstractor will select the "Chart Abstracted" button in EPIC. This will serve as an indicator in EPIC that the patient's chart has been abstracted and also identify the abstractor who has closed the chart.
