





## **Accessing the SmartPhrase Analyzer/Editor**

1. From *Epic*, click Tools > SmartTool Editor> My SmartPhrases.

You can also access the SmartPhrase editor from the notes activity.




Hint: If you have created some text you would like to use for a dot phrase, copy it before clicking the green plus sign.



## **Creating the .dot Phrase**

- The SmartPhrase editor displays. Click New from the tool bar.
- 2. Type the name of your new SmartPhrase in the SmartPhrase Name field.
- 3. Type the desired text.
- Click **Accept** at the bottom when finished.



SmartLinks can be added by typing in the **dot phrase**. It then appears with an @ symbol on either side.



## **Personalizing a Smart Text**




From the SmartPhrase Editor select the desired SmartText template and click **Accept**. This places it in the SmartPhrase editor field for modification.

1. To edit an already existing SmartPhrase, highlight the phrase, and click **Edit**.





2. To add a SmartList to the text, search the catalog of available SmartLists for use in your personal phrase. (Ex: type "yes" to search for a yes/no drop list. Select the desired list).



 Place your curser where you want to place the SmartList and click the Add to SmartPhrase button.

**Wildcards:** You can place a wild card anywhere in the text where you want to be sure to add text. Wildcards are 3 asterisks \*\*\*. When you press **F2** and arrive on a wildcard, you can 'fill in the blank'. Don't bother deleting the \*\*\*. Once highlighted (black background), they automatically disappear when you start typing.
